Job Description:

The Grand County School District, School-based Therapist position is for our high school, grades 9-12 in Grand County School District located in Moab, Utah. The School-based Therapist is responsible for providing direct mental health services and neurofeedback training, in a timely manner, to high school age students experiencing behavioral and/or mental health difficulties. The therapist may also provide consultation services to school staff to support the overall mental health goals of the schools. The therapist must have a high degree of self-motivation and initiation. Preference will be given to those with current BCIA Certification or one who is willing to complete certification within 6 months.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- 1. Provide direct mental health services including intake assessment, individual/family/group therapy, and crisis intervention to assigned clients.
- 2. Maintain regular contact with the parent/guardian of each client (if appropriate).
- 3. Complete treatment plans, treatment plan updates, progress notes.
- 4. Furnishes reports/updates to Juvenile Court, DCFS, school principals, school guidance counselors, teachers, treatment teams, and other involved agencies.
- 5. Attends regularly scheduled school staff meetings and clinical supervision meetings.
- 6. Provides consultation for school staff regarding mental health issues, as needed/requested by staff/administrators.
- 7. Provides complete and timely documentation to support services rendered.
- 8. Must consistently demonstrate the ability to establish and maintain good public relations with families, referral agencies and other community resources through appropriate organizational, written, and verbal skills.
- 9. Willingness to engage and grow in cultural competency.
- 10. Attends trainings/conferences with a neurobiology approach to treatment to improve therapeutic skills. (position includes a generous CE stipend)
- 11. Must have excellent attendance.
- 12. Other duties assigned.

Knowledge/Skills:

Must possess a strong knowledge of the common diagnoses and neuroscience based treatments for children ages 14-18 and possess the skills necessary to facilitate positive change in the school environment. Must possess an understanding of how trauma affects brain development and have trauma informed treatment skills.

Education/Experience:

- 1. Master's degree from an accredited University or College in the field of Social Work, Psychology or related field.
- 2. Licensed in the State of Utah to provide mental health services.
- 3. Experienced and comfortable working therapeutically with children ages 14-18.
- 4. Preference will be given to those with current BCIA Certification or one who is willing to complete certification within 6 months.
- 5. Preference given to applicants with specific trauma treatment training such as neurofeedback/ neuromodulation, EMDR, somatic experiencing, IFS.
