Part-Time Neurofeedback Position

Brain Health Clinic is actively seeking a master's level intern or licensed professional for a part time clinical neurofeedback position. Brain Health Clinic is a private sole proprietorship located in East Sacramento near Sacramento State University. The clinic serves children, teens, adults, and older adults with a variety of neurotherapy. Our philosophy encompasses a variety of holistic approaches to brain health as we believe a healthy brain can only run on and supported by a healthy constitution. Our vision is to restore the brain-body integration through attending to the gut, nervous system and brain.

The position of neurofeedback clinician will be responsible to assess patient symptoms and treatment needs, create treatment plans and review patient progress, and manage overall treatment using neurofeedback modalities. Key areas of expertise for this position are assessment, diagnosis and clinical interview skills, ability to work with computers and technology, and excellent people skills. HRV biofeedback (or BCB certification) experience is preferred but not required. The position is also required to engage in professional development of neurofeedback skills and knowledge base on a regular basis, consistent with the nature of rapid change and expansion occurring in the field.

In addition to working effectively in isolation or with very little supervision, the person hired will be trained in the basics of neurofeedback and must be competent to develop and maintain technical neurofeedback training skills, including patient preparation, signal acquisition, protocol monitoring, file record-keeping and clean-up regimens. The NFB Clinician must be able to run NFB training and QEEG acquisition sessions proficiently, as needed. Following the probationary term of 6 months this position will increase to 40 hours a week and this clinician will function as the clinical director with oversight and profit sharing of the practice.

EDUCATION REQUIRED: You have a minimum of a bachelor's degree in any of social work, psychology, counseling, or a mental-health related field that is licensable as posted on the BCIA requirements. You have a basic understanding of neuroanatomy and neurophysiology; neurofeedback and biofeedback and you are willing (Continuing education will be required) to learn new material as it is presented. You are BCIA neurofeedback certified or you are in pursuit of board certification within a 12-month time frame (we will require registration toward certification within the first 3 months if already not certified).

COMPENSATION: \$15-\$20 hourly starting wage or a wage commensurate with credentials and experience. Preference will be given to those already licensed in the State of California or master's level interns as well as having education or training in Neurofeedback. Mentoring as required for BCIA Certification can be a part of this compensation package.
