What does a Neurofeedback Psychologist do?

- Administers Neurofeedback brain training and qEEGs to adults and children.
- Assumes responsibility for the execution of the Neurofeedback Training Plan.
- Coordinates scheduling of appointments and keeps track of sessions delivered to plan.
- Selects and adjusts neurofeedback protocols to maximize effectiveness of training.
- Tracks, charts and monitors patient's training sessions and symptomatic progress.
- Reviews patient progress and training effectiveness with the patient's caregiver or patient.
- Keeps the treatment room clean, stocked and prepared for each patient session.
- Ideally is capable of performing psychological assessments or other mental health assessments, such as for autism to bring more value to the clients.

The position:

We are seeking grounded, growth oriented **Licensed Professionals** who have a deep desire to see change and progress in their patients. We are interested in professionals who will be willing to be trained and certified in neurofeedback within the first year of being with us. This will require additional training on your part in addition to the training you will receive from us.



Essential Responsibilities include:

In addition to working effectively in isolation or with very little supervision, the person hired will be trained in the basics of neurofeedback and must be competent to develop and maintain technical neurofeedback training skills, including patient preparation, signal acquisition, protocol monitoring, file record-keeping and clean-up regimens. The NFB Clinician must be able to run NFB training and QEEG acquisition sessions proficiently, as needed. You will be well trained and well supported by the head office. Following the probationary term of 6 months this position will increase to 40 hours a week and this clinician will function as the Licensed Clinical Director.

Education Required:

You have a minimum of a Master's degree and a **License to practice in California** in any of social work, psychology, neuroscience, counseling, or a mental-health related field. Prefer a Ph.D and a Psychologist.

You have a basic understanding of neuroanatomy and neurophysiology; neurofeedback and biofeedback and you are willing (Continuing education will be required) to learn new material as it is presented. You are willing to be BCIA neurofeedback certified or you are in pursuit of board certification within a 12-month time frame of being hired at our clinic. Our ideal candidate must have an interest in neuroscience and integrative psychology. Brain health and lifestyle issues are of strong interest for you.

Compensation:

\$20 - \$25 per hour for undergraduate work or wage commensurate with credentials and experience for neurofeedback technician positions. For licensed clinicians salary will be discussed based on prior knowledge and experience with neurofeedback.

Preference will be given to those already licensed in the State of California or Master's level interns as well as having education or training in Neurofeedback. Free mentoring towards board certification valued at \$2500 included in the compensation package. Benefits include health insurance, paid sick time and worker's compensation.

Licensed Masters Clinicians or Ph D. Psychologists will receive remuneration based on experience.

Full-time. Hours fluctuate based on clients. Monday-Friday and Some Saturdays Schedule depending on case load (scheduling flexibility an asset): 10, 4 or 8 hour shifts
