What does a Neurofeedback tech do?

- Administers Neurofeedback brain training and qEEGs to adults and children.
- Assumes responsibility for the execution of the Neurofeedback Training Plan.
- Coordinates scheduling of appointments and keeps track of sessions delivered to plan.
- Selects and adjusts neurofeedback protocols to maximize effectiveness of training.
- Tracks, charts and monitors patient's training sessions and symptomatic progress.
- Reviews patient progress and training effectiveness with the patient's caregiver or patient.
- Keeps the treatment room clean, stocked and prepared for each patient session.

What is Neurofeedback?

Neurofeedback (NFB), also called neurobiofeedback, is a type of biofeedback that uses real-time displays of brain activity, most commonly electroencephalography (EEG), to teach self-regulation of brain function. Sensors are placed on the scalp by using a cap to measure electrical activity, with feedback presented using video displays or sound. There is significant evidence and research supporting neurotherapy for generalized treatment of multiple conditions, including anxiety, depression, ADD/ADHD, autism, memory, cognitive functioning, and even sports enhancement. It has been used for over four decades. NFB is relatively non-invasive and is administered as a long-term treatment option, typically taking a month to complete.
